Sponsor Scholarships

The SDPA sponsors the **Becker-Hansen Memorial Scholarship** that goes to a SD resident who is earning a pilot's license or an advanced rating and must be trained by a SD-based instructor. The scholarship was established in 1998 to honor the memory of state pilots Ron Becker and Dave Hansen who died in the crash of the state's MU-2 with Governor George S. Mickelson and five others.

The SDPA sponsors the **SDPA Aviation Maintenance Technology Scholarship** at the Lake Area Technical College (Watertown). The scholarship was established in 2005, and goes to a 2nd year student in the Aviation Program for tuition.



Co-sponsor SD Aviation Art Contest

The South Dakota Office of Aeronautics has sponsored the SD Aviation Art Contest for several years. In 2005 SDPA became a co-sponsor of the SD Aviation Art Contest. The SDPA provides funding for prizes for the winners of the contest in three age categories: 6-9, 10-13, and 14-17.
